STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

EC supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under our jurisdiction.

Under the EC Statement of Principles, all persons shall be committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that all equestrians, including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Actively promoting the development of, and adherence to, competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The Show Committee reserves the right to add, amend or delete any point not covered by the rules & to correct any error or make any necessary changes in the Prize List or Program. The Show Committee reserves the right to add classes or make necessary changes to tentative schedule but will exercise this with ample notice given to exhibitors affected by changes.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of EC and AHA. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of the rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections will automatically become part of this Prize List. Questions that arise that are not covered by either AHA or EC rulebooks will be decided by the Show Committee and their decisions will be final.
2. **Per Article A801**, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and the horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all the rules of EC and any additional rules set by competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rule imposed by the competition.
3. Exhibitors must ascertain when their stock will be judged. **Calling of classes is a courtesy only.** Exhibitors failing check-in at the hitching ring may have their animals excluded from their class.
4. **Gate holds** will be allowed with the discretion of the Show Committee and must be requested through the Hitching Ring personnel and/or Show Office well before the class (preferably before the session starts). The show committee will make every effort to accommodate tack changes; time restriction will be 3 minutes. Tack changes to be completed in the hitching ring area.
5. Any classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the show committee. Entrants shall be notified. All changes will be posted at the show office. Additions to class list may be considered by the Show Committee.
6. **SAFETY REGULATION: EC Article A905**
 - (1) At all times, persons mounted or carriage driving at an EC Sanctioned event location must wear approved protective headgear as described below.
Exceptions: See discipline or breed sport rules:
Section B – Arabian: B1306.7, B1501.22, B1602.3, B1702.3, B1802.3, B1902.5, B2002.4, B2402.4, B2402.6, B2403.3, B2610.3, B3002.9, B3604.5, B3605.2, B3605.5, B3606.2, B3611.2, B3701.4
 - (2) Protective Headgear must be:
 - a) Approved by an accredited certification organization. See glossary – Headgear Standards;
 - b) Properly fitted; and
 - c) Securely fastened by a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.
 - (3) Any competitor may wear approved protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the Judge.
 - (4) EC makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any approved protective headgear. EC cautions riders and drivers that serious injury or death may result despite wearing such headgear, as all equestrian sports involve inherent risk, and no protective headgear can protect against all foreseeable injury.

7. Dogs are NOT permitted on the show grounds.

8. Horses will be permitted to leave the show grounds during the competition and return as necessary.

ACCIDENTS & RETURN TO PLAY

1. This rule is applicable to all competitors (including foreign) at EC sanctioned events and applies to falls/accidents that occur at the event location.
2. In the event of a fall/accident where a concussion can be reasonably suspected, (not limited to a direct blow to the head or loss of consciousness), the competitor must receive medical clearance by qualified medical personnel onsite, through the EC Accident Injury Report Form before continuing. The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the onsite medical assessment takes place by the onsite qualified medical personnel. If the competitor refuses to be evaluated, he/she is disqualified from the event.
3. If the qualified medical personnel suspects a concussion (regardless of symptoms displayed), or believes that the competitor may be at risk of concussion due to the nature of the fall or impact, the competitor is suspended from competition until medically released, as outlined in paragraph 6 below.
4. In the case of the preceding paragraphs, an EC Accident/Injury Report Form must be completed by either the attending Steward, Technical Delegate or the attending qualified medical personnel onsite and submitted to EC within 24 hours of the occurrence. It is the Steward's / Technical Delegate's responsibility to ensure forms are complete and submitted on time.
5. Any competitor suspended from competing further at the event on the basis of any of the preceding paragraphs will be placed on a medical suspension list, managed by EC, until medically released as in the process described in paragraph 6.
6. In the event a competitor is determined ineligible to compete per one of the above conditions, the competitor must submit the EC Return to Play Form to EC, completed by a licensed physician. The EC Return to Play Form will be processed by EC within two business days, at which point the competitor will be removed from the EC Medical Suspension list and may return to regular competition. If the competitor wishes to compete after being medically released by a physician but before the EC processing period of the form, the competitor must also submit a copy of the EC Return to Play Form to the show secretary. In this case the competitor is competing at their own risk and may be pursuant to fines and penalties if the form is found to be incomplete in any way.
7. No competitor shall compete in an EC sanctioned event while on the EC Medical Suspension List. It is the responsibility of the competitor to refrain from competition and the competition organiser may refuse entry to anyone currently on the EC Medical Suspension List.
8. These rules also apply to EC sanctioned competitors competing in FEI and USEF competitions.

MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION

1. Horses entering any classes must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR), The Arabian Horse Registry of America or the AHA or any other duly recognized registry if the horse is owned by a citizen of a foreign county. Horses must be entered under their full registered name with their registration number, or if an age specified by breed rules, as eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the name(s) of the owner or lessee of the record with the breed association. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with the entry form at the time the entry is made.
 2. **EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.**
WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.
EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSE ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.
EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS / GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)
 3. All owners, drivers, riders, lessees, agents or trainers must hold an EC Competitive License (Bronze level for this show) or if a US citizen, hold a valid USEF membership.
Visit www.equestrian.ca to obtain sport license information.
 4. Amateur Status designation on an EC Competitive License (or Amateur card with USEF membership) is required for individuals wishing to exhibit in Amateur classes. You must apply for this card at the same time you apply for the Competitive License. Refer to EC General Regulations and Breed specific rules on Amateur Status to determine eligibility.
 5. For all EC Sport Licenses to be valid, a current membership in the Alberta Equestrian Federation (or other Provincial Sport Organization - PSO) is required. AEF membership and information can be obtained at www.albertaequestrian.com

 2. Post entries will be charged a \$25 late fee for horses not entered prior to April 28, 2017, plus class fees.
- Post entries will be accepted at the show up to one session prior to the post entered class.**

3. ENTRY FEES:

REGULAR PERFORMANCE AND IN-HAND

"TBA/Buy a Class" classes offered for purchase at this show and will be "sold" on a first come first serve basis.

Classes must be from the TBA/Buy A Class list included in this prize list. The Show Committee reserves the right to approve the class proposed for purchase.

4. An office fee of \$12 per horse will be charged for all entries.
5. As of January 1, 1991, all sanctioned AHA shows must collect a mandatory fee per horse entered per show. This is in accordance to the 1990 convention resolution #9/90 that addressed mandatory funding for the new Judges, Commission and Education/Evaluation Committee. To compensate for the US exchange rate, the Spring Fling Society will be charging \$7.00 CAD (\$5 + \$2 exchange).
6. All sanctioned AHA shows are required to collect the AHA Show Recognition Fees which are \$6.00 CAD (\$4 + \$2 exchange) per horse, per show.
7. No entry fee will be refunded except on receipt of a Veterinarian's Certificate. The Veterinarian's Certificate shall be presented to the Show Secretary before refund is granted and must be presented before 10:00 pm Friday April 7, 2017. The office fee \$12 per horse will be retained by the Spring Fling, with all other fees returned to the horse owner. There is no substitution of horses for any reason.
8. A charge of \$30 will be levied for cheques returned by the bank for any reason. Exhibitors with returned cheques will not be allowed to show unless a certified cheque, cash or money order is presented to the Show Secretary.
9. Every horse shall be assigned a number. This number must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring. Any exhibitor using the wrong number, or having no number in the ring may be excused from the class or may be disqualified in the event of a protest. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that they are wearing the correct number in the class.
10. A mandatory EC Drug Testing Fee of \$3.50 will be charged per horse. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.
11. The Show Committee reserves the right to reject any entry at any time as per article A805.
12. The Show Committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes having fewer than 3 entries at closing of entries. Exhibitors will be notified if classes cancelled due to low entries. All changes will be posted at the Show Office. Please ensure your classes appear in the show program as entered.
13. Hors concurs allowed. These entries must pay

the same entry fee and are subject to the same conditions that apply to regular entries as outlined in the division rules. Hors concurs entries are not eligible for any awards. Please notify steward.

14. All entries must be made on the official entry form (photocopy as needed) and be properly signed by the owner or authorized agent. All Junior competitor entries must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

- ✓ Full address of owner
- ✓ Signature of owner
- ✓ Copies of all membership cards; this includes AHA, EC, AEF

PRIZES

1. All classes will receive ribbons to fifth place. No prize money will be awarded.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

1. Junior Horses are 5 years and under as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Juniors are 18 years and under as of December 1, 2016.
3. AHA Medal Class Specifications: Refer to the Arabian Division, Equitation Section of the EC Rule Book (Chapter 36 of the Breeds Rules see B3608 along with Class Specifications in B3609).
4. Two Minute Gate. In collective classes, the gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than two minutes after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses.
